### BIKE SAFETY - TIPS FOR CHILDREN

Riding a bike is great fun and good exercise for children and teens. Here are a few tips to keep your children safe while cycling:

- Children under 10 should be supervised when riding a bike.
- Children should be taught the rules of the road before they ride by themselves.
- Riding in the driveway should not be encouraged. Children need to know that the driveway is dangerous. Teach them to stop at the end of the driveway, look, listen, and think about whether it is safe to cross the road.
- Every child needs a helmet that fits correctly. Helmets should be worn at all times when riding. Parents should set a good example by wearing a helmet themselves.
- Children's bicycles should be kept in good condition and have the appropriate reflectors.
- Children should wear bright coloured clothing when riding.

## From the Classroom

Hello,

In Mathematics this term, students have been learning all about Measurement. They have been exploring the length, volume, capacity and area of shapes and items using formal and informal units. The language can be very complex and using a hands-on approach really helps to engage the students and embed concepts taught. Currently, students are looking at capacity and volume in regards to Litres (L) and Millilitres (mL). We extend our learning by heading outdoors to the sandpit and water trough. There, students are able to explore using various containers. They learn how to measure out correctly and find out how much each container holds and what will hold more or less. To make it even more, engaging the water may even be a different colour! Working collaboratively also provides opportunities to learn off each other and have some great discussions.

Over the next two weeks, our students will also be attending swimming lessons every morning. During news telling, they shall be speaking about: Why it is important that we learn how to swim. I look forward to hearing all their reasons.
