## ANIMAL REGISTRATIONS

Dog and Cat Registrations are due for renewal on the 31 October 2024. Reminders will be sent out in the coming weeks. Should you need to register your animals, please come into the office.

## MAGPIE SEASON

Please be aware that magpie swooping season is in full swing, so it's important to protect yourself and your children. To stay safe, wear a hat, put on sunglasses, and consider carrying an umbrella for extra protection. Remember, never provoke or harass magpies, as this can make them more aggressive. Swooping season typically lasts for about 6 to 8 weeks, so stay vigilant during this time.

**RESTRICTED BURNING PERIOD**  
**19 SEPTEMBER TO 31 OCTOBER**

**WHAT YOU CANT DO**

- Burning of grass, paddock, bush and bonfires without a permit.

**WHAT CAN YOU DO**

- Use of Wood/Solid Fuel, BBQ's & Pizza Ovens.

Except when the Fire Danger Rating System is High or above or on a Total Fire Ban.

**THINGS TO CHECK**

- Check the Fire Danger Rating
- Check that there is NO Total Fire Ban
- Have suitable equipment to contain and control your burn

**CONTACT YOUR NEAREST FCO TO OBTAIN A PERMIT**

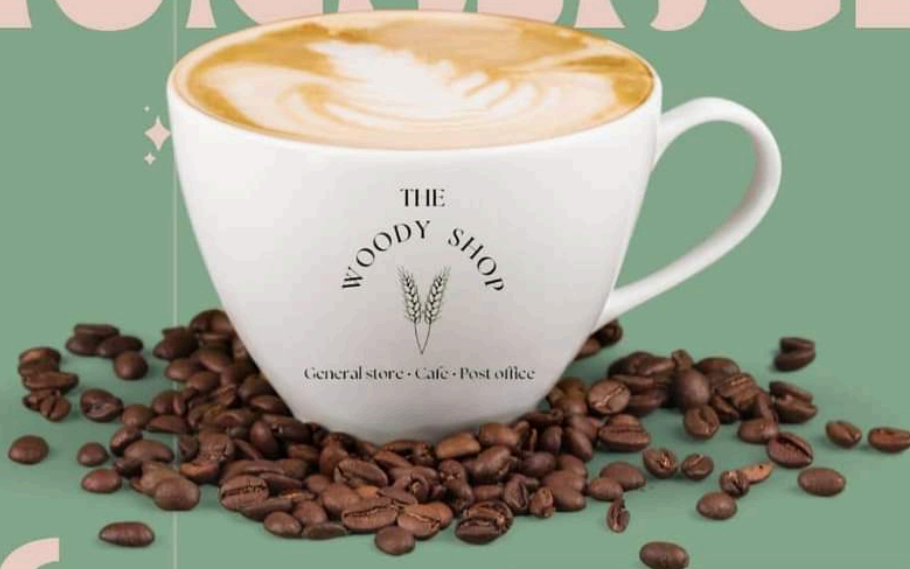

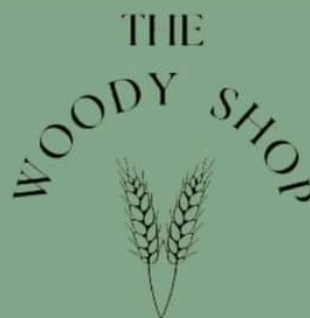

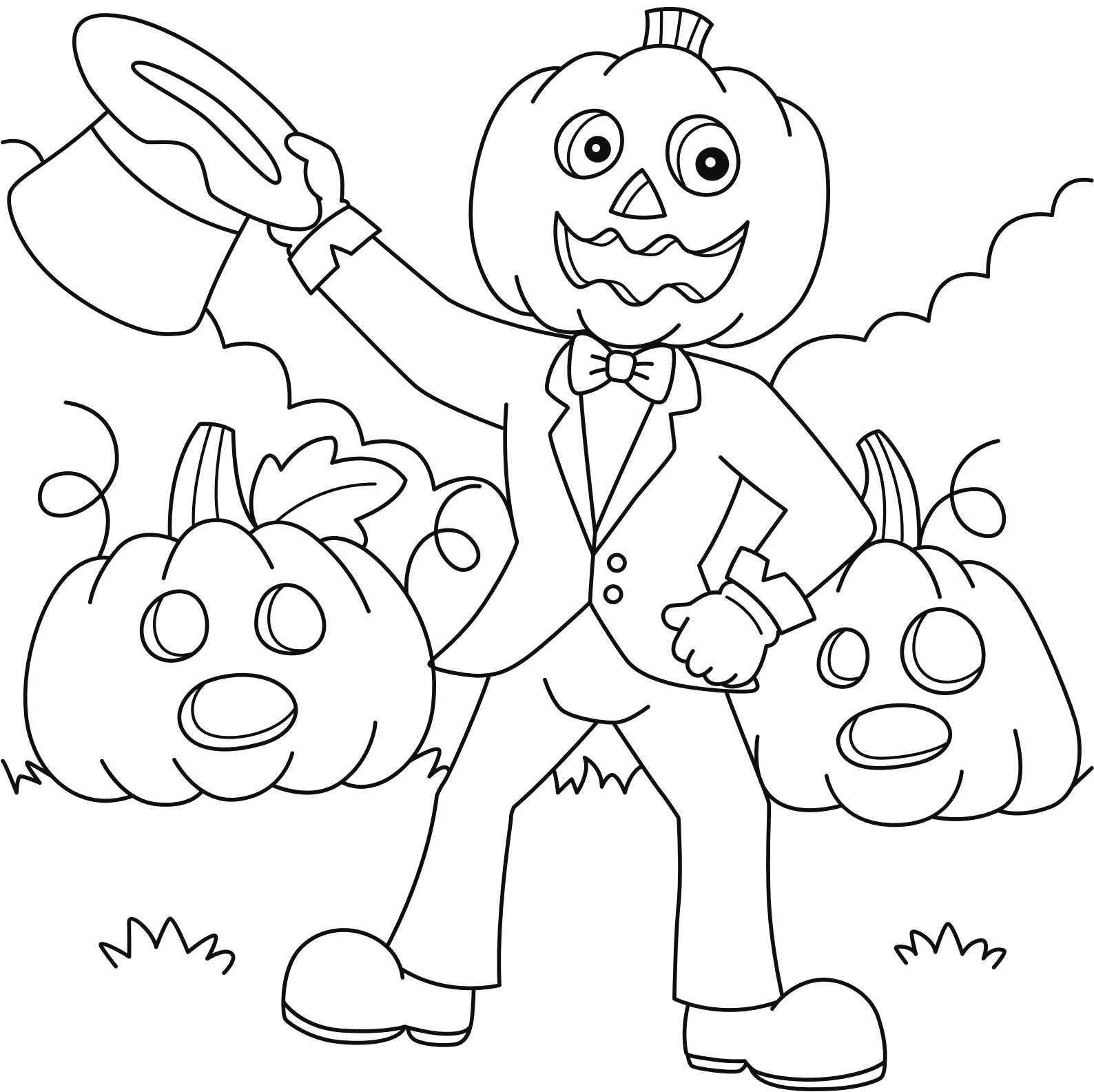

# RECIPES

## WATERMELON FETA SALAD

### INGREDIENTS

4 cups watermelon,  
cubed  
1 cup feta cheese,  
crumbled  
1/4 cup fresh mint  
leaves, chopped  
1/4 red onion, thinly  
sliced  
Juice of 1 lime  
2 tablespoons olive oil  
Salt and pepper to taste  
Optional: Balsamic glaze  
for drizzling

### Step 1

In a large bowl, combine the cubed watermelon, crumbled feta cheese, chopped mint leaves, and thinly sliced red onion.

### Step 2

In a small bowl, whisk together the lime juice, olive oil, salt, and pepper.

### Step 3

Drizzle the dressing over the watermelon mixture and gently toss to combine, ensuring the watermelon and feta are well coated.

### Step 4

Transfer the salad to a serving platter. If desired, drizzle with balsamic glaze for added flavour. and enjoy.





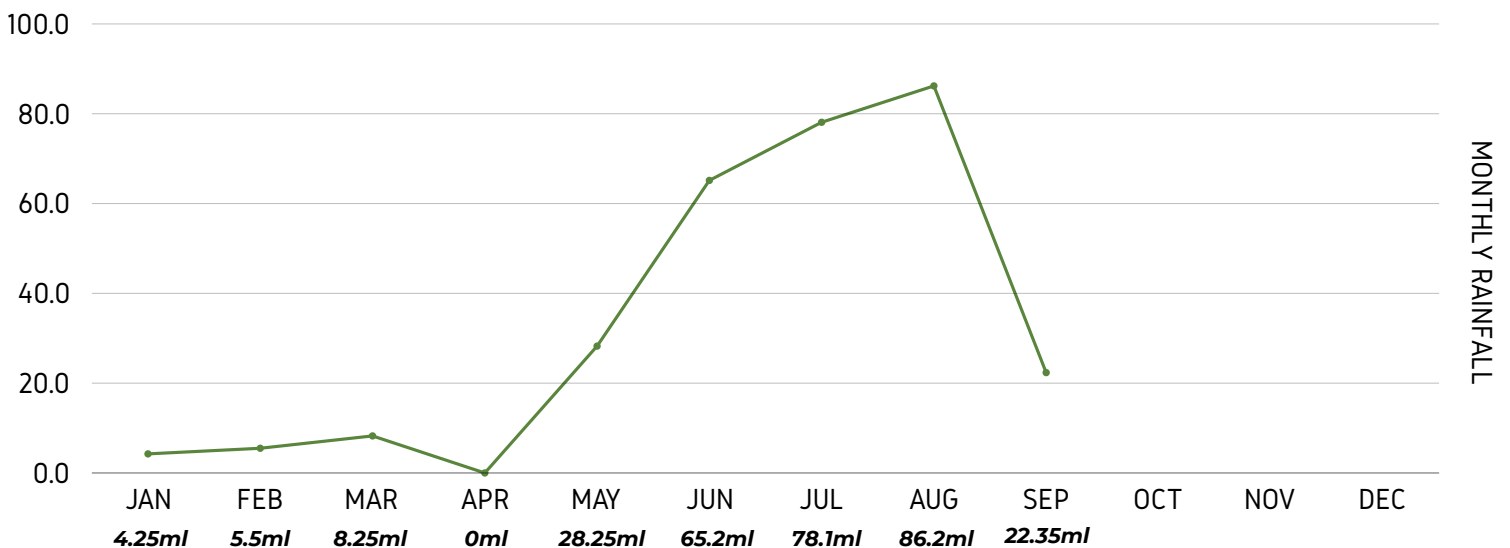
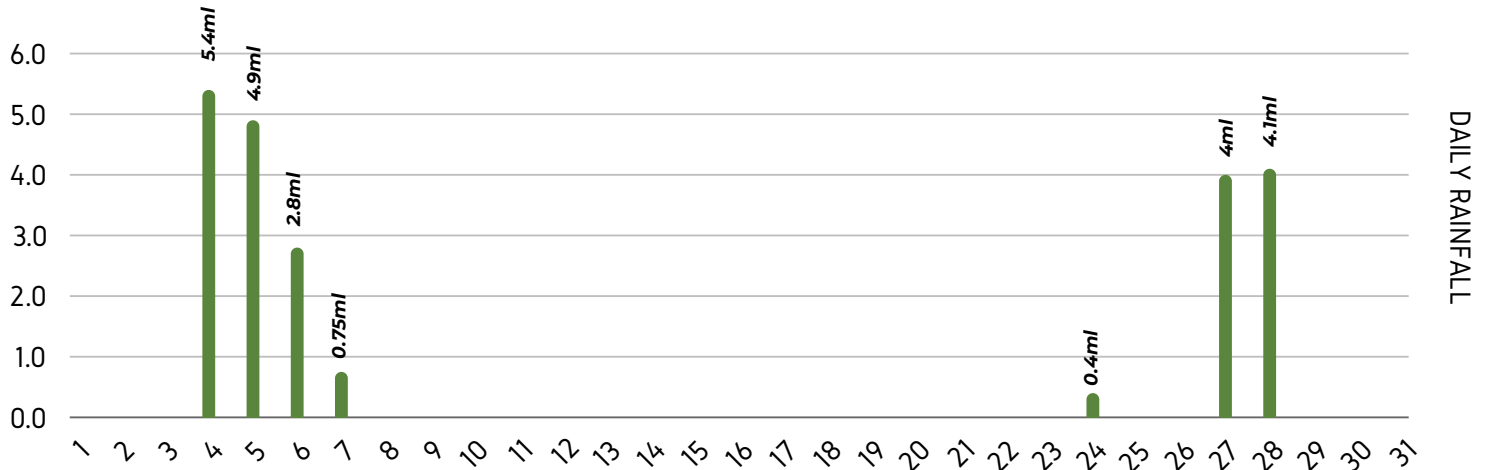
